This will add many positive changes to your tenant rights, from payment of rent to eviction rights, and mediation on rent control. A copy of the FMO "Watchdog" has been emailed to you and is available on their website. I urge you to call the state legislators listed and let them know you are in favor of this bill. You do not have to be a US citizen or live full time in Florida; you just need to give your address in our community when calling.

**Did you know?** There are two types of HOA's in Florida. Mobile Home Park Lot Tenancies are covered in Florida Statutes Chapter 723, our HOA is governed by subsections 723.075 through 723.079. As you know ELS operates our community. Communities that are operated by HOA's are governed by FS 720.
