Drive 6.9 miles, turn right onto 579N (Handcart Rd). Go about 3.9 miles, station is on right. Furniture and appliances for free. TVs are \$5 or \$10

PAPER & CARDBOARD

Paper & Cardboard Recycling is open for the summer months, on the 2nd and 4th Saturdays from 10am—noon. Accepted items are clean, dry paper and cardboard. Please break down the cardboard boxes and remove metal staples and all tape. No plastic bags or shredded material. DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS OUTSIDE OF THE COLLECTION AREA
