The board met with ELS in mid-January. They provided some updates on the repairs to our post office. They have a vendor and are awaiting completed paperwork to begin the construction. We hope to see the construction begin in February. The repairs to the sidewalk at the corner of Utopia and Paquette have been completed. There was no update on the CapEx Projects for 2021. We will follow up again at our next meeting..

ELS advised us that due to some manpower constraints, they were not able to complete the 360° inspections. They plan to continue and complete those inspections in the near future.

The board proposed hosting a COVID 19 Vaccine clinic here in the park. We are advised that ELS approved this proposal and a committee was formed to begin planning that event. We have spoken to the county and our community is on a list with the county waiting to be advised when doses of the vaccine are available to us.

COVID Vaccine Updates

We are continuing to work with Pasco County Emergency Management to bring a vaccine clinic to our community. At this time, we have a list of over 600 residents who have asked to be added to the wait list. We do not know the date nor the number of doses of vaccine the county will have for us, so please continue to seek alternative methods to receive the vaccination. We do ask that if you are successful at getting the vaccine elsewhere, you contact us so we can remove you from our list.

If you are computer savvy, an alternative method to register for the vaccine is through the website *patientportalfl.com*. If you are at least 65 years old and a Florida resident, you can register on this site. Follow the instructions to register and then check back often to see when doses and appointments become available.



Rules and Regulations: We understand there are some concerns that the community is no longer a 55+community. Here is Rule #3, as written by ELS in the Forest Lake Estates Rule and Regulations. If you feel that there is a problem, complete a resident concern form, submit it to the office and ask for a signed, dated copy for your records. If you want the HOA to follow up on the concern, please provide a copy to any of the HOA Board Members.

3. 55 AND OLDER COMMUNITY


This Community is intended and operated for occupancy by persons 55 years of age and older and, as such, adheres to the requirements of the Housing for Older Persons Act of 1995. Consequently, at least 80 percent of the occupied units must be occupied by at least one person who is 55 years of age or older as of the date of occupancy.

At the time of application for initial residency, or upon demand of Community Management, all prospective residents and all existing residents shall be required to produce for inspection and copying, one of the following age verification documents: driver's license; birth certificate; passport; immigration card; military identification; other valid local, state, national or international documents containing a birth date of comparable reliability or a certification in a lease, rental agreement, application, affidavit or other document signed by any member of a household over the age of 18, asserting the age of the persons residing therein. The minimum age for all residents is forty (40). Notwithstanding the above, Community Management reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to grant exceptions to the minimum age requirements of this Rule, while still maintaining compliance with the Housing for Older Persons Act of 1995.

On January 1st of each even numbered year, Community Management shall provide existing residents with a notice that the resident shall provide the names and ages of all current persons residing in the home. Failure to provide the written resident documentation shall constitute a violation of these Rules and Regulations and the resident may be subject to eviction pursuant to Section 723.061, Florida Statutes.

The purpose of the Forest Lake Estates Home Owners' Association (FLE HOA) is to ensure our membership and our perspective members are aware of the goals of our Association. We are now conducting our 2021 Membership Campaign.

Our mandate is to:

- Operate an Association encompassing the well-being of the business affairs of the Forest Lake Estates Home Owners' Association.
- Promote FRIENDSHIP and HARMONY between FLE HOA and the Park Owners, ELS.
- Ensure rent increases are REASONABLE AND WORTHY; and,
- Ensure ELS is in compliance with 723 F.S., the Prospectus, and all exhibits thereto.

While it is important to maintain a harmonious relationship between FLE Residents and ELS, it is also important to know that the FLE HOA stands firm on these mandates. All Forest Lake Estates residents have an investment that must be protected. The FLE HOA is the ONLY entity recognized by the State of Florida to represent all of the residents in the Park. The HOA works with ELS to assure that the park is maintained appropriately and to protect the best interests of all residents. All residents are encouraged to join the HOA and support the HOA Board of Directors as they work to support you. From November through MidJanuary, membership sales are held in the clubhouse on Mondays from 10:00AM until 12 Noon. The dues are \$20 per household per year and are deposited into our general fund to be used for operating expenses, activities and legal support. Members who provide an email address will receive the monthly newsletter, minutes of membership meetings and any announcements via email. You may choose to have a hardcopy newsletter delivered to your home November to April. Newsletters are only delivered in the summer to members without email. Board Members are elected each year in January. You must be a paid member to be eligible to run for a seat on the board and to vote in the election.


ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIPS are available for Renters only


Resident Concern Forms

During our last meeting with ELS, the HOA board discussed the fact that many residents have reported to the HOA that calls to ELS were not being returned and concerns were not being handled. The response from ELS was that concerns should be filed in writing. Although we know the process can be cumbersome, it would benefit all of us, if, when you have a concern, you complete the Resident Concern Form, bring the completed form to the office, have them sign and date the form (this acknowledges receipt of the form) and ask for a copy. If you would also provide any member of the HOA Board with a copy, we will then have a record and paper trail which we can use to follow up. We cannot stress this enough. The paper trail is important when there is no response to a written concern.

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
