Play Organization MUST PLAY ON WEDNESDAY TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SKINS.

- Putt- putt is each Wednesday; each person must pay \$1 toward skins when they check in at the scorer table.
- Players will be given scorecards and assigned their opponents. Play new opponents each week.
- After playing 18 holes, the foursome will turn in scorecard at the scorer table.
- Each team should double check score on the scorecard.
- If there is a weather-related cancellation, the following week two rounds will be played.
- Makeups are only as follows: TUESDAY 10:00 11:00 AM or THURSDAY 3:00 4:00 PM.

Play Procedures

- On ODD numbered weeks, the designated female player will putt all ODD holes first.
- On EVEN numbered weeks, the designated male player will putt all ODD holes first.
- Replay the hole if a player plays out of turn, and it is recognized before group leaves the hole.
- If more than two holes are played out of turn, the match must be replayed.

Basic Rules of Play

- Maximum number of strokes to be scored is 6; maximum number a team can post per round is 54.
- If the ball rests near sidewalk, rock, brick or item on the course, place the ball six inches from the obstacle. This is about the length of any US paper currency.
- If a putt is hit off the course, take a one stroke penalty then place the ball where it was hit out of bounds, but not closer to the hole or line of flight.
- Ball hit into the white stones (#2, #11, & #13), place back on the tee, add penalty stroke, & partner hits 3rd shot.
- Ball stuck under the bridge on hole #14, pick up and place on the side of the bridge toward hole on the X.

The purpose of the Forest Lake Estates Home Owners' Association (FLE HOA) is to ensure our membership and our perspective members are aware of the goals of our Association. We are now conducting our 2022 Membership Campaign.

Our mandate is to:

- Operate an Association encompassing the well-being of the business affairs of the Forest Lake Estates Home Owners' Association.
- Promote FRIENDSHIP and HARMONY between FLE HOA and the Park Owners, ELS.
- Ensure rent increases are REASONABLE AND WORTHY; and,
- Ensure ELS is in compliance with 723 F.S., the Prospectus, and all exhibits thereto.

While it is important to maintain a harmonious relationship between FLE Residents and ELS, it is also important to know that the FLE HOA stands firm on these mandates. All Forest Lake Estates residents have an investment that must be protected. The FLE HOA is the ONLY entity recognized by the State of Florida to represent all of the residents in the Park. The HOA works with ELS to assure that the park is maintained appropriately and to protect the best interests of all residents. All residents are encouraged to join the HOA and support the HOA Board of Directors as they work to support you. From November through Mid-January, membership sales are held in the clubhouse on Mondays from 10:00AM until 12 Noon. The dues are \$20 per household per year and are deposited into our general fund to be used for operating expenses, activities and legal support. Members who provide an email address will receive the monthly newsletter, minutes of membership meeting and any announcements via email. You must be a paid member to be eligible to run for a seat on the board and to vote in the election.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIPS are available for Renters only

Associate Members will have all the benefits of Members but cannot run for election or vote. The fee is \$15.00 per household. Please contact Janice Collins for the application. (813-788-5678). The Associate Member Form is different from the HOA Membership Form.

PAPER & CARDBOARD







Synopsis of Communication Expenses

The FLE HOA currently uses 4 methods of communication:

- Personal Meetings once a month, annual cost \$0.00
- Website FLE-HOA.com, annual cost \$132.95
- Mailchimp our email server, annual cost \$251.88
- Newsletter printed copies, annual cost approx. \$4,895 (although the full newsletter is available on our website, free of charge to all HOA members) also (the newsletter is averaging \$2 per hard copy per month during the "season").


The HOA board has had many discussions on this topic. With increased expenses for an attorney (which we don't think will go away) we need to do something to reduce our annual expenses, thereby increasing our General Fund, which should be there and should be sizable enough to support us through an emergency. Synopsis of Communication Expenses (continued from page 22)

We know you like the hard copies of the newsletter and are asking you all to consider some changes to help us reduce our expenses. Below are the options the board would like you to consider and be prepared to vote on at the December meeting:

- Change nothing and hope our funds support any litigation that may occur.
- Shut down the website which would result in a savings of \$132.95 annually
- Reduce our "mailchimp" account, but that would reduce the number of people we could have in our contact list, as well as the number of emails we would be allowed to send.
- Go with the Community Media version of the newsletter. This is a company that will print newsletters for free. We provide the info to the management office, they send it along with their own information to Community Media. Community media then does the layout of the newsletter, places ads from their advertisers in the newsletter and provides information of their choice to fill any empty space. This would save us \$4,895 in printing fees, but we would lose over \$7000 of income from our own advertisers. The newsletter would also not "feel" like our own newsletter.
- Share the cost of printing the newsletter. If you want a hard copy, you could pay an additional \$10 to receive hard copies of the newsletter while you are here in Florida.
- Increase the annual membership fee to offset some of the newsletter expense.
- Eliminate all hard copies of the newsletters.
